

Ordinance 2026-2
SALARY ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN
WARREN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY

Be it ordained, BY THE Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County OF Warren, State of New Jersey that:

1. The compensation of each member of the Township Committee of the Township of Franklin, County of Warren and State of New Jersey shall be and the same is hereby set at \$2,900.00 per annum, payable quarterly, Mayor \$4,938.00 per year.
2. The salaries and wages of the Officers and other employees of the Township of Franklin, County of Warren, and State of New Jersey hereinafter set forth, shall be as follows:
